- The facilitator understands that there is no compensation offered for their participation.
- The facilitator has previous experience in facilitation or training.

Workshops will be chosen for quality of content, target group and relevance of the subject to the overall theme of the ICF annual conference.

The better you can summarize your presentation and demonstrate your abilities as a facilitator, the better your chances of being selected.
